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The CPIT Library, Learning & Information Services is part of the Education Services Division. Our mission is:

Library, Learning & Information Services provides student-centred resources and services, which support the delivery of education and research at CPIT and promote independent and successful learning in an environment that values diversity and is accessible by all.

The Work-Group consisting of the Library; Learning Services (incl. Information Literacy); eLearning; Disability Services, Careers Centre, CAPL (Centre for Assessment of Prior Learning) work together in the areas of strategic management, research support, information skills delivery, academic approval impact reports, marketing/promotion of resources and services, working with students to become more successful, and through active partnerships in the teaching, learning and information management processes across the institution.

Library staffing totals approximately 15.75 full time equivalents includes the following roles:-

- Librarian (reporting to the Manager, Library, Learning & Information Services)
- Access Librarian - responsible for the Access Team including 3 FTE Assistant Librarians – Access (technical services) and 4.75 FTE Library Assistants plus funding for shelvers).
- Digital Services Librarian - responsible for the Assistant Librarian – Digital
- Liaison Librarians – 4 FTE

The Library is based at the City Campus and provides a specialised service to the Trades Innovation Institute at the Sullivan Avenue Campus. Our collections and services are closely aligned to teaching subjects. Areas of strength include nursing, midwifery, medical imaging, broadcasting, business, computing, outdoor recreation, social services, hospitality, English language, design and the Trades.

We have been operating the Voyager library management system since December 2003. We are involved in a number of institutional repository initiatives. Database subscriptions include EPIC, Ebsco & Proquest delivering over 10,000 full text journal titles plus EBook Library, Safari & NetLibrary e-book platforms.
